- 1. Cover Letter (1-2 pages)
- Intellectual significance + intervention
- Fit with series and press mission
- Platform (Google Scholar h-index, public lectures, media)
- 2. Full Proposal (8-12 pages)
- Abstract (250 words)
- Contribution to field (with key debates cited)

- Chapter-by-chapter outline (150–200 words each)
- Audience segmentation (primary: academic subfield; secondary: adjacent fields/public)
- 3–5 **comparable scholarly titles** + 2 **crossover comps** (why yours bridges both)
- Timeline to completion
- 3. Sample Chapter (20–30 pages)
- Must include apparatus (notes, bibliography)
- Demonstrate analytic rigour + narrative clarity
- 4. CV(s)
- · Highlight peer-reviewed work, grants, public engagement
- For edited volumes: contributor list with affiliations + 150-word bios
- 5. Peer Review Plan
- Suggest 4–6 potential reviewers (no co-authors or advisors from past 7 years)
- We secure blind double-peer review

Fast-Track Editorial Process

- 1. **Desk Review** (1 week)
- Confirm completeness, formatting, and production readiness
- 2. Blind Double-Peer Review (4 weeks)
- Full manuscript (both types)
- Reports shared anonymised
- 3. **Contract** (within 5 weeks)
- 4. **Production** (2–3 months)
- Copyedit → Design → Proofs → Print/Digital
